

9. LIST OF AGENCIES, ORGANIZATIONS AND PERSONS CONTACTED

During development of the proposed project the CDWR consulted with several agencies, including the USFS, USFWS, CDFG, and United. Discussions with these agencies included, but were not limited to, the proposed water release regime, operational constraints associated with Pyramid Dam, issues affecting arroyo toad and its habitat both generally and as they relate specifically to upper and middle Piru Creeks, issues associated with middle Piru Creek's trout fishery, compliance with FESA, and potential mitigation measures for adverse impacts that could result from the proposed project.

During preparation of this Draft EIR, several agencies and technical experts were also contacted to discuss the proposed project and its alternatives. Table 9-1 provides a listing of the agencies, organizations, and persons contacted during preparation of this document. In addition to this list, Appendix A of this Draft EIR includes the CEQA distribution list that identifies all parties that have been directly notified of the project's environmental review. Appendix B contains the letters to the persons contacted for the purposes of the project's cultural resources investigation.
